



Captain Bell is not among the casualties on the 1909 plaque.

Captain Bell was mortally wounded in the battle. He died the next day at Pemberton's old (had a crop in a prior growing season) field on Broad River. The bodies were carried on to Matthew Fondren's abandoned field north of Buffalo Creek. He and Colonel James Williams were initially buried in the same grave. They were later separated and re-interred.

James Hignight named Captain Bell as a casualty in his 1833 Lee County VA deposition.
