The plaque of casualties on the 1909 obelisk at Kings Mountain does not mention Martin Gambill.

Nancy Nall Gambill, wife of Martin and daughter of Captain William Nall of Ashe County North Carolina, testified to the various militia services of her husband. Specifically Martin Gambill was a captain under Colonel Benjamin Cleveland at the Battle of Kings Mountain in which he was wounded by an enemy musket ball which remained **lodged in his left arm** and rendered him crippled from further military service and from most of his civil pursuits.

Several certificates were produced in Ashe County court to prove that Gambill was a captain.
