



Daniel Sisk and Thomas Bicknell of Wilkes County NC have been called the last two casualties from the Battle of Kings Mountain. Conflicting records show Daniel as the son of John Sisk born in 1754 in Wilkes County or in Shenandoah County or in Culpeper County.

1775 Wilkes County tax lists show Daniel Sisk. Draper's book without the E was the source for the 1909 monument plaque which shows Siske. Draper spelled Bicknell to which the E was added by county clerks in pension records showing Biecknell.

28Jul1784 Wilkes County ordered that the sum of 15 Pounds a year be given to the orphans of Daniel Sisk

25Oct1784 Benjamin Cleveland, Chairman of the County Court, appointed Gabriel Loving guardian to four minor orphans of Daniel Sisk, deceased. (Wilkes County WB 1, p. 144) Gabriel had married the widow Rachel Sisk.

Born in Shenandoah County and moved to Wilkes
Married Rachel Loving in Shenandoah in 1771?
