



Private Martin Hammond is not listed on the 1909 monument bronze plaque of patriot casualties at Kings Mountain.

Bobby Gilmer Moss in *The Patriots at Kings Mountain* lists multiple payments by South Carolina to Martin Hammond, wounded at Kings Mountain. They are recorded in audited accounts such as AA3279 retained on microfilm in state archives at Columbia and the museum at McColvey Center in York SC.

02Sep1785 SC paid £8.15 to Martin Hammond, wounded at Kings Mountain.

Payment by the state five years after the battle indicates a serious wound with ongoing disability.

Records from SC militia units list Martin Hammond under Colonel Thomas Brandon, Captain Benjamin Jolly in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Spartan regiment.
