

Robert Walker was born in 1736 in Augusta County Virginia. He died 14Apr1793 in Chester County South Carolina where he was buried at Fishing Creek Presbyterian Church Cemetery.

Private Robert Walker is not listed on the 1909 monument bronze plaque of patriot casualties at Kings Mountain.

Bobby Gilmer Moss in *The Patriots at Kings Mountain* lists multiple payments by South Carolina to Robert Walker, wounded at Kings Mountain. They are recorded in audited accounts such as AA8486 and 8139 retained on microfilm in state archives at Columbia and the museum at McColvey Center in York SC.
