



James Conn was born 18Jul1751 in Philadelphia. He enlisted from Orange County NC, then moved to Lincoln County NC. He served in a number of actions prior to the Battle of Kings Mountain.

James Conn was one of Colonel Graham's South Fork militia. He moved from Major Chronicle to Colonel Williams' command at Kings Mountain. The further movement to Colonel Campbell's command was for the purpose of tending to the wounded after the Lincoln County and Colonel Williams corps were bereft of officers.

A crippling musket ball wound to the right shoulder left Conn a crippled man for life.

The 1909 obelisk plaque does not name Conn among the casualties.

Conn applied for a pension in Russell County KY on 15Feb1834. An annual pension of \$80 was granted retroactive to 04Mar1831.
