

Morgan Griffin

On 24Nov1855, Martha Coons, daughter of Morgan Griffin, deceased, applied for an heir's pension in Richland District, South Carolina. In her deposition, she stated that her father fought at the Battle of Cowpens and was wounded in the war seven times.

Morgan Griffin was a pensioned veteran, but his deposition did not mention Cowpens. In fact, Morgan stated that he was imprisoned in May 1780 and his enlistment expired while he was in prison.
