

## James Hawthorn

In *The Patriots at the Cowpens*, Dr. Bobby G Moss wrote that Colonel James Hawthorn was wounded at Cowpens. Lyman Copeland Draper, in *Kings Mountain and its Heroes*, shows Hawthorn wounded with Sumter's remnants in February 1781 instead. Draper did not have access to SC audited accounts as did Bobby.

Other Patriots with Hawthorn mentioned the encounter at Fort Granby (Friday's Fort on the Congaree) in February but not Cowpens. For certain, James was a well known and respected patriot leader in South Carolina and Kentucky.
