We cannot tell who James Lambert saw at Cowpens with a shattered arm. He was not specific as to officers on the Cowpens Deployment. Neither was there a Major Guy Hamilton in other sources.

James Lambert (R6099) from Rockingham Co VA

He was frequently engaged in foraging parties and in scouts and was in many places the names of which he cannot remember. He was marched to the **Cowpens** in January 1781 and was there in the Battle. He here saw Colonel Hillyard he thinks riding along the line **with one arm hanging down shattered by a musket Ball**. He will also mention one circumstances somewhat significant, a woman was engaged in doing something to a man that had fallen by the shot of the enemy. She was in the attitude of stooping and a Ball from a Swivall [swivel gun] struck her on a straight line and literally split her open.

Colonel Hillyard mentioned from Rockingham CO VA

There was a Colonel Charles Hillyard from Dover Delaware not mentioned at Cowpens.
