

Thomas Holston

On 27Nov1821, in Kent County, DL, **Thomas Holston** filed a deposition (FPA s36018) for the renewal of his invalid pension. He stated:

That he enlisted in the year 1777. or 1778. as he believes, at Lewis town [sic: Lewes] in the County of Sussex in the said State, in Captain John Larmoth's [sic: John Learmonth's] Company attached to the Delaware Regiment which belonged to the Continental establishment in the said War; that his said enlistment was for during the War; that he was at the battle of Campden [Camden SC, 16 Aug 1780] and there taken prisoner; that he was afterward put under Captain [Robert] Kirkwood who belonged to the Regiment aforesaid; that he served in the last mentioned company till he was discharged after the termination of the said War; that he was at the Battle of the **Cowpens** [17 Jan 1781] also, where he received a **very serious wound in the right arm.**
