

John Lindsay

Bobby Moss in *The Patriots at the Cowpens* lists John Lindsay, died of wounds received at Cowpens. Bobby cites annuitant's claims from South Carolina audited accounts and the deposition of John's nephew, Moses Lindsay.

In Moses Lindsay's deposition (FPA S4551), he states that John Lindsay was his uncle, but does not mention that he was wounded. Among the many details, that would be a fact unlikely to be omitted.

James Kincaid swore that he served under Captain **John Lindsay** in the **latter part of 1781**. Joseph Brown testified that he was under Captain John Lindsay and did not mention him wounded or killed.
