

On 26Mar1897, Amanda Knox Fuller applied for a dependent's pension in Carroll County KY. She stated that her father, **Robert Knox** died 03Oct1836 as a result of wounds received at the battle at the **Cowpens**. It is obviously unbelievable that mortal wounds caused death after 55 years. It is also beyond credibility that Robert Knox and the others who testified in his pension application (FPA W26190) in the 1830s would have failed to specify service at Cowpens and failed to mention a wound except one from the battle at Rocky Mount.
