Years after the battle at the Cowpens, Molly Guthrey spoke of an occurrence of 17Jan1781. She (maiden name Llewellyn aka Louallen) lived on Thicketty Creek near the battlefield. Molly and her little brother heard the noise from the battle. Their father, not in the battle, was mistaken for a tory and killed. The account was published in the *Spartanburg Express* on 24Jul1861.
