

Phillip Stuart of Charles County MD (later taken into the District of Columbia) received pension payments (FPA S20989) due to disabling wounds while in service during the Revolutionary War. Philip served in the 3rd Virginia Cavalry Regiment under Colonel William Washington. That regiment was in several engagements as part of Nathaniel Greene's new southern army during 1780 and 1781. One of them was Tarleton's Defeat at the Cowpens on Wednesday morning 17Jan1781.
