

The Johnsons lived nine miles down Yadkin River below Wilkesboro on the Roaring River.

James Gray, a foot soldier under Captain Herndon, testified that Samuel Johnson was captain of cavalry who got wounded by a ball across the abdomen at Kings Mountain.

James Martin was the pension agent for Johnson's disability pension arranged by Senator Jesse Franklin, a nephew of Benjamin Cleveland and a close friend of Samuel Johnson.

Samuel Johnson (1757-1834) was a son of Jeffrey Johnson and Rachel Walker. He moved from Prince William (later Fauquier) County, Virginia to Wilkes County, North Carolina and married Mary Hammons (Hammonds?)
