



John Fox was in Colonel Benjamin Cleveland's Wilkes County militia under Captain Joel Lewis. He was wounded by a musket ball in the left arm which lodged in his left side and remained there throughout his life. John is not listed on the 1909 Kings Mountain bronze plaque of patriot casualties.

John Fox died 01Sep1840 in Knox County Tennessee where his widow Virlintia (maiden name unspecified) filed for a widow's pension without proof of marriage. John is buried in Knox County on Emory Road a mile west of Clinton Highway.
