

Jacob Anderson and Thomas Crawford gave supporting testimony to each other's pension applications. Crawford deposed that Anderson was **wounded at Cowpens**. There was no evidence that his regiment was at Cowpens. Bobby Moss did not list Anderson as a participant at Cowpens. Anderson deposed that Crawford was wounded and that Anderson shot the Indian who wounded him.

Jacob Anderson (FPA S37675) applied for a pension on 15Feb1819 in Frederick County VA at age 62 (so born 1757). Jacob deposed that he joined the army in 1777 under Captain William Darke of Colonel Abraham Bowman's 8th Virginia Regiment and served until discharged in Morristown NJ in 1782. He was inoculated for smallpox. Anderson fought at Brandywine, Germantown, and Monmouth and received three wounds. Anderson received a hardship pension (certificate 12,551) under the Act of 18Mar1818.

Thomas Crawford on 29Mar1819 at age 61 applied for a disability hardship pension. He deposed in Frederick County VA that he enlisted in PA in 1776 under Captain William Croghan of the 8th Virginia Regt commanded by Col. Abraham Bowman. At the end of the war he was discharged at Chemung NY> He fought in the Battles of Monmouth [28Jun1778], Brandywine [11Sep1777], Germantown, [04Oct1777] & New [illegible word]. Jacob Anderson deposed that Crawford was wounded and that Anderson shot the Indian who wounded him.

Another Jacob Anderson (FPA r184) also lived in old Frederick County.

Another Jacob Anderson was born 03Nov1731 in Bedford County, VA.

About 1759, Jacob married Mary Callaway, daughter of Lt Col William Callaway and Elizabeth Tilly Callaway. Jacob Anderson died 26Nov1822 in Bedford County VA (Buford Co GA according to some family researchers).

The May1778 will of George Anderson proved in Bedford Co., VA. bequeathed property to son Jacob. Jacob, William and John Anderson were listed with the Bedford Co. Militia. Jacob held rank of sergeant.
