

Samuel Ellis applied for a pension (FPA 530400) 03Oct1833 in Russell County, KY.

Born 09Apr1762 in Montgomery County, MD. After the War he moved around some, the last move from Cumberland County KY to Russell County in 1832.

Samuel enlisted in Rowan County NC in the militia under Captain Samuel Reid and Colonel Francis Locke. They deployed to the Yadkin River to suppress Tory gatherings. His next tour was under Captain David Campbell and Colonel Robert Irwin. In his third tour, he was at the Battle of the **Cowpens** where he was wounded in the arm. John Scott of Cumberland County testified that he was with Ellis in most of his tours of service.
