

Saunders' Cattle



Tory Hiram Saunders feigned illness and did not come out of his house on Tuesday, 16Jan1781. The patriot troops “accepted his generous offer” of some beeves. Saunders’ cattle were killed in action at the patriot BBQ on the day before the battle. Note: Two of Saunders beeves were killed by Captain Andrew Colville’s men on Friday 06Oct1780 to feed the “overmountain men” before the battle of Kings Mountain.
