Brothers William and Thomas Price served with their father, Capt Thomas Price.

They were refugees from Rutherford Co NC to Greasy Cove where they joined John Sevier's patriots for the BKM expedition. Thomas Jr was kicked by a horse and left to tend the pack animals, probably at Cowpens. William and Thomas Sr were in the battle.

Capt. Price was killed in combat in 1781. His sons moved to White County TN.

After BKM, the Loyalists were herded to Aaron Biggerstaff's plantation (Bostic NC) where a court martial sentenced 36 to death. Most notorious among them was Col Ambrose Mills whose Tories had haunted the Price neighborhood. Mills was among the nine hanged to death. While there, Samuel Newell's neighbors, Thomas McCullough and James Laird succumbed to their battle wounds. At least a dozen wounded patriots made it on up Cane Creek to Burke County court house and Doctor Dotson's care.
